SUMMARY: The Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS) series was designed to provide comprehensive information on various aspects of postsecondary education in the United States and its territories (American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and the Marshall Islands) and Department of Defense schools outside of the United States. Data are available for both public and private two-year and four-year institutions. The HEGIS College and University Libraries component for 1970-1971/1971-1972 sought data on libraries in institutions of higher education. Key data elements, presented for up to 19 record types, number library collections and resources, physical of facilities, number of positions for library staff, salary expenditures, number of hours of assistance and expenditures for wages of library staff, number of employees, level of employees' educational attainment, library operating expenditures and budget, funds received for library services, and developmental areas.

UNIVERSE: Libraries within all postsecondary institutions in operation during 1970-1971 and 1971-1972 in the United States and its territories (American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and the Marshall Islands) and Department of Defense schools outside of the United States.

NOTE: (1) The HEGIS Record Layout file (Part 2) is an Excel worksheet of record layouts for all components of the HEGIS survey, including the 1970-1971/1971-1972 Libraries component. (2) This collection has not been processed by ICPSR staff. ICPSR is distributing the data and documentation for this collection in essentially the same form in which they were received. When appropriate, hardcopy documentation has been converted to machine-readable form and variables have been recoded to ensure respondents' anonymity. - C. NEED FOR ESTIMATES. Do not leave any items blank. Enter "O" if the appropriate entry for an item is zero or "none." If an exact figure is not available for a particular item, but the amount is known to be greater than zero, EN-TER AN ESTIMATE of the amount. Indicate the estimated data by parentheses (). SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

PART I - LIBRARY COLLECTION, 1970-71

- E. VOLUME. For reporting purposes, a volume is a physical unit of any printed, typewritten, handwritten, mimeographed, or processed work contained in one binding or portfolio, hard-bound or paperbound, which has been cataloged, classified, and/or made ready for use.
- F. PRINTED GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS. A printed government document is any publication in book or serial form bearing a government imprint, e.g., the publications of Federal, State, local, and foreign governments and of world organizations, such as United Nations, European Common Market, etc.
- G. MICROFORM AND MICROFILM. All forms of microform (including microfilm) are to be excluded from lines 10 and 11, but ARE TO BE REPORTED SEPARATELY on lines 12 and 13. If the number of reels or other units of microform are not separately available in your records, please estimate their number for purposes of providing separate data here.
- H. PERIODICALS. A periodical is a publication issued in parts that usually contain articles by several contributors. It generally has a distinctive title and the successive numbers or parts are intended to appear at stated intervals, usually for an indefinite period.

PART II - LIBRARY STAFFING, FALL 1971, AND LIBRARY EXPENDITURES FOR SALARIES AND WAGES, 1970-71

I. REGULAR AND HOURLY STAFF. REGULAR STAFF is defined as staff in full-time and part-time positions, usually serving with salary contracts. HOURLY STAFF is defined as non-regular staff. reported as EITHER regular staff positions OR hourly staff positions, but NOT IN BOTH CATEGORIES. The fall 1971 number of REGULAR STAFF positions, filled (men and women) and vacant, 9 - 10 months and 11 - 12 months, should be reported only in columns (1) through (6) for lines 15 through 18. The salary expenditures for REGULAR STAFF, 1970-71, should be reported only in columns (1) and (2) for lines 19 through 22. The number of hours of assistance and the expenditures for wages of library staff serving on an HOURLY basis, 1970-71, should be reported only on lines 23 and 24. Note that column (3), line 24, on wages not charged to the library, is requested to round out data which otherwise would be incomplete.

- J. LIBRARIAN, PROFESSIONAL, CLERICAL, AND OTHER STAFF. LIBRARIANS (lines 15 and 19) are defined as staff doing work that requires training and skill in the theoretical or scientific aspect of library work, as distinct from its mechanical or clerical aspect. PROFESSIONAL STAFF OTHER THAN LIBRARIANS (lines 16 and 20) are persons who, though not librarians, are in positions normally requiring at least a bachelor's degree. CLERICAL AND OTHER STAFF ON LIBRARY BUDGET (lines 17 and 21) are persons in technical assistance, receiving, shipping, storing, secretarial duties, etc. (exclusive of custodial service) who are specifically assigned to the library and are covered in the library budget.
- K. CONTRIBUTED SERVICE STAFF. CONTRIBUTED SERVICE STAFF ordinarily should be reported only by religious institutions or institutions affiliated with religious or theological organizations. PUBLICALLY CONTROLLED institutions receiving contributed or volunteer service (if any) should EXCLUDE data on such service in this report.
- L. FULL-TIME EQUIVALENTS OF REGULAR STAFF. The positions of all regular staff members (other than those reported as hourly staff) should be reported in terms of FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT (FTE) UNITS. Full-time equivalents are defined as the number of positions of a given staff level of persons who serve the library on a full-time basis, PLUS the full-time equivalent of any positions of the same staff level of persons who serve the library on LESS than a full-time basis. (Assume that the term "full-time" is defined as it is used by your business office.) For the purposes of completing lines 15 through 18, note the following examples of service which should be counted as a .5 FTE:
 - a. A position for a person employed by your institution on a half-time basis throughout the year, and serving the library exclusively during that period.
 - b. A position for a person employed by your institution on a full-time basis throughout the year, but who EITHER serves the LIBRARY only half-time during the year, OR serves the LIBRARY full-time during only one-half of the year.
 - PART III LIBRARY OPERATING EXPENDITURES, 1970-71, AND BUDGET 1971-72
- M. AMOUNT. Report only funds expended for the academic year 1970-71 and in the budget for the academic year 1971-72, regardless of when the funds may have been received from Federal, State, or other sources. Report all expenditure and budget figures as whole dollars only—OMIT CENTS.

- N. SALARY EXPENDITURE DATA. To insure accurate reporting, please have your business officer assist with the entries made in lines 15 through 34, and 38. Include expenditures and budget data for contract salaries before any deductions, but exclude "fringe benefits" provided by your institution.
- O. OPERATING EXPENDITURES OTHER THAN SALA-RIES. Expenditures for books and other printed materials (line 25) should INCLUDE expenditures for materials in micro form. Expenditures for audiovisual and other nonprint materials (line 26) should EXCLUDE expenditures for materials in microform. Audiovisual and other nonprint materials. include: (1) slides, transparencies, filmstrips, and films OTHER THAN those whose primary purpose is the reduction in size of printed materials; (2) dial-access program materials audio-tape, video-tape, and disk (phono-record) recordings; and (3) study prints, art prints, art objects, posters, charts, diagrams, globes, maps, kits, and realia (e.g., museum materials). Do NOT include microforms with audiovisual and other nonprint materials. Expenditures for automation services (line 28) should include only such expenditures included in the LIBRARY budget. Other operating expenditures charged to your library, other than salaries and wages (line 30) should include expenditures for REPLACING equipment and furnishings; however, expenditures for capital outlay should be EXCLUDED from this form.
- P. EXPENDITURES FOR LIBRARY SERVICE PROVIDED FOR ANY COMPONENTS OF YOUR INSTITUTION FROM OUTSIDE YOUR INSTITUTION'S OWN LIBRARY. Line 29 and items 35 through 37 are provided for the delineation of such services. For example, at times institutions start a branch campus in a place where fairly adequate temporary library service can be obtained from another nearby library, such as a public, industrial, military, or other academic library. While the new branch campus is developing its own library, the parent institution may arrange for library service to be provided from the outside source.

PART IV - FUNDS RECEIVED FOR SERVICES PROVIDED TO CLIENTELE OUTSIDE OF YOUR INSTITUTION, 1970-71

Q. There is an increasing tendency for academic libraries to provide specialized services beyond those covered by ordinary interlibrary transactions. Items 38 through 41 are provided to show the incidence and magnitude of such services.

PART V - DEVELOPMENTAL AREAS: INTERLIBRARY COOPERATION, COMMUNITY OUTREACH, AUDIO-VISUAL AND/OR OTHER NONPRINT MATERIALS, FALL 1971

R. Cooperation among academic and other types of libraries, the extension of user privileges beyond an institution's own students, faculty, and staff, and the provision by academic institutions of a centralized, organized collection of audiovisual and/or other nonprint materials, are developmental areas that are expanding greatly. Items 42 through 45 are provided to indicate the strengths of these trends.
